The Vanishing Loser

Both vulnerable. South deals. The bidding:

SOUTH	WEST	NORTH	EAST
2♥	Pass	4♥	Pass
Pass	Pass		

Opening lead: Ace of Spades

It is again time for us to run some of Eddie Kantar's "Thinking Bridge" deals, designed for players eager to improve their game and published in the Daily Bulletins of the Fall ACBL North American Championships in Seattle.

"South has a near maximum weak-two opening bid and North has a choice of responses. A raise to four hearts is reasonable as is two no trump, asking for more information. If North tries two no trump, South bids three clubs, showing a feature – the ace or king. This might encourage North to bid three no trump, which happens to be cold.

"As East, give count in spades. After declarer has pre-empted or bid two suits and partner leads the ace, presumably from ace-king and dummy has the queen, third hand gives count playing the deuce – the lowest from an odd number of cards. As West, it looks right to switch to a low club. Partner figures to have an honor or two in the

suit given the fact that South has a weak hand. As East play the king of clubs at trick two, the higher of unequal honors. If you had equal honors such as the queen-jack, you would play your lower equal.

"As South, you start with nine top tricks – six hearts, the diamond ace-king and the ace of clubs. Rather than pin your hopes on the diamond finesse, use dummy's queen-jack of spades to develop your tenth trick. Win the ace of clubs, draw trumps ending in dummy and lead the queen of spades, discarding a club. West wins the king, cashes the queen of clubs and leads a third club that you ruff. All that is left is to cross to dummy with a diamond and discard a diamond on the jack of spades. No diamond finesse is necessary..."

The longevity payment by way of salary, shall be paid bi-weekly and shall be reported to the appropriate New Jersey Pension Fund, together with the annual salary as "Regular Base Salary" as part of the officer or employee's salaries. The longevity program is herein set forth for each officer or employee who is eligible on the date of hire per practice and shall continue until such time as the officer or employee retires. The longevity payment shall not be compounded annually; it shall be added to the annual salary as the salary may be increased.

3. **EDUCATIONAL CREDITS:**
In addition to the annual salary, each full-time officer shall receive educational credit payment according to the following schedule:

Associates Degree (or 60 credit hours)	\$ 500.00
Bachelors Degree	\$1,000.00
Masters Degree	\$1,500.00

The educational credit shall be paid in addition to the base salary, shall be paid bi-weekly and shall be reported to the appropriate New Jersey Pension Fund together with the annual salary.
Employees hired after March 15, 2004 shall, if qualified, receive the educational credit set forth upon completion of one (1) year of service to the Borough or within thirty (30) days after earning the appropriate degree and submitting proof of each degree to the Borough. The educational credit payment for these employees shall be a one-time payment for each degree earned and shall not be reflected in base salary.
4. The salaries hereinabove prescribed shall take effect on January 1, 2012.
5. The salaries and rates of compensation herein provided supersede all previous salaries and rates of pay heretofore by ordinance established.
6. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE POSITIONS OF HARBOR MANAGER AND HARBOR CLIENT SERVICES REPRESENTATIVE AS WELL AS FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF ATLANTIC HIGHLANDS, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2012**

WHEREAS the Borough of Atlantic Highlands and the Atlantic Highlands Harbor Commission desire to abolish the Position of Harbor Master and create the position of Harbor Manager, as well as re-title the position of Harbor Utility Collector/Secretary, to Client Services Representative; and,
